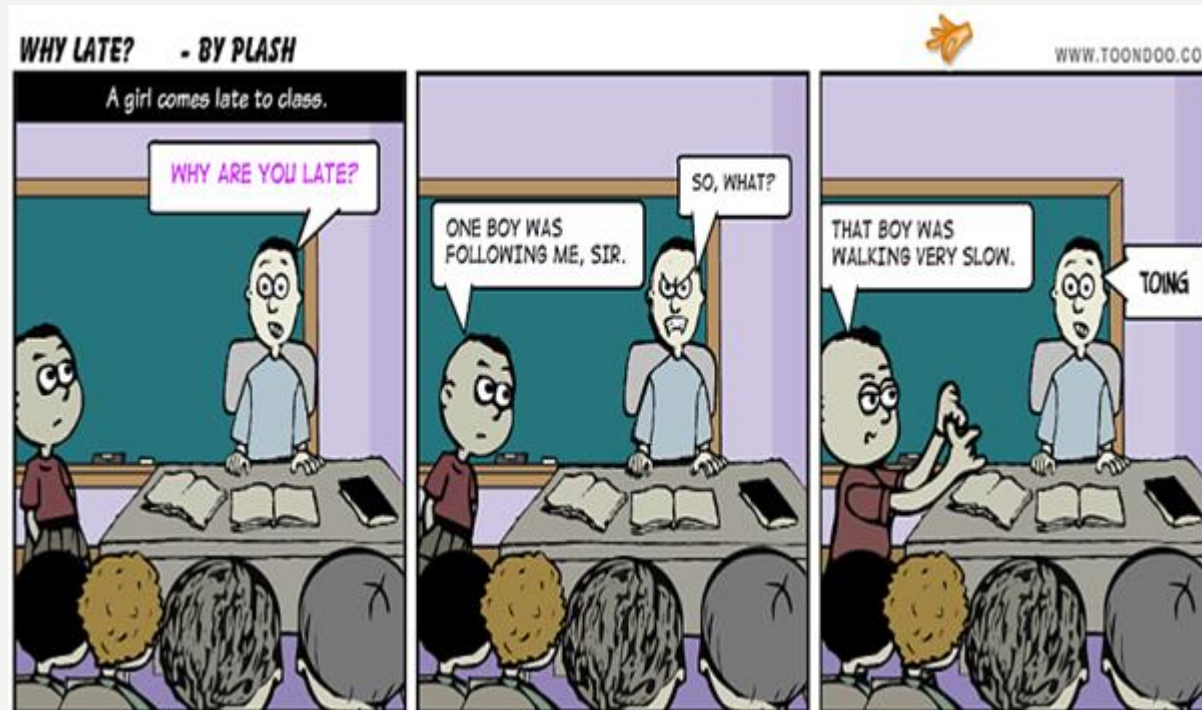
LEARNING INTENT: STUDENTS WILL UNDERSTAND THE IMPORTANCE OF BEING ON TIME

- Success Criteria:
 - Identify the reasons why we need to always be on time
 - Identify the cause and effects in the scenarios

- Vocabulary:
 - Punctual



WHAT DO WE MEAN BY PUNCTUAL?

- In class on time, lined up, waiting to enter the classroom
- Ready to learn with all our equipment
- Have eaten
- Have been to the toilet, had a drink (or have a water bottle filled)



UPDATE:

- You must be at your class when the SECOND BELL RINGS after lunch times, or as quickly as possible for the start of period 3.
- Drinks are not an excuse to leave the classroom- bring a water bottle and make sure it is filled during your lunch time.
- Unless you have a valid reason, you will not be allowed to leave the classroom at the start of a lesson for a toilet break. This is especially the case when the lesson comes straight after lunch.
- You must have the teacher's tag or a note to leave the classroom.

UPDATE:

- No more than two students should be out of the class, unless there is a valid reason. This means that you may have to wait (and therefore be prepared by going during lunch times).
- When out of class you need to be as prompt as possible. If you take too long, your teacher may decide to give you a detention to catch up on missed work.
- If you are late to school- you need to sign in at Mrs Harrison's window. This includes during lunch times. You are not to go straight to class.

WHY?

- You miss important messages, information and class tasks.
- You disturb the learning of other students by interrupting, leaving the room, returning, etc.
- Outside of school, your work may limit your breaks or access to facilities might be limited. Therefore it is important to practice being prepared.
- Seniors- being constantly late or out of class will be reflected on your School Reference. This could impact your future employment.

If you come to school by bus or dropped off by parent

- remain inside the school grounds until the end of the day
