- It looks like active learning.
- It looks like safe behaviour.
- It looks like immediate response to teacher direction.

- Visitors to the school/ contractors (especially in unsafe, construction areas)

WHAT CAN YOU DO IF YOU FEEL THE REQUEST IS UNREASONABLE?

There are **POSITIVE** ways to handle situations that you find negative:

- 1. Ask to speak to the adult about it in a polite way. You may need to wait for an appropriate time. Being aggressive or refusing a request is **NOT** a positive way to resolve something.
- 2. If you don't feel like a positive outcome has not been reached, try speaking to another staff member in the school- Heads of Year, Heads of Department, Deputy Principal, Support Worx Staff. Again you might need to make an appointment, and ensure you are speaking to the correct person for your issue.
- 3. It is **NEVER** ok to feel bullied. Clarify with a safe person about whether the situation is bullying. If it needs reporting, the school has STYMIE to report issues like this.

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- Positive rewards at ESHS:

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- Real life implications
 - Failure to follow instructions outside of school can result in:

 - Injury (self and others)
