KEEPING THE PLAYGROUND CLEAN:

- Some playground areas are classrooms and rubbish interferes with the learning
 - Putting our rubbish away keeps pests away and stops them destroying sections of our school
 - It makes our school hygienic. Rubbish (especially food waste) can cause bacteria and mould to spread.
 - Plastics and other waste is destroying our environment, and killing native animals.
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- If there is rubbish in the area where you sit- you will be expected to pick it up. Even if it isn't yours.
