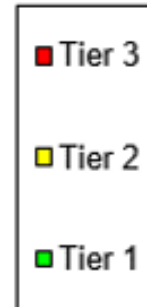
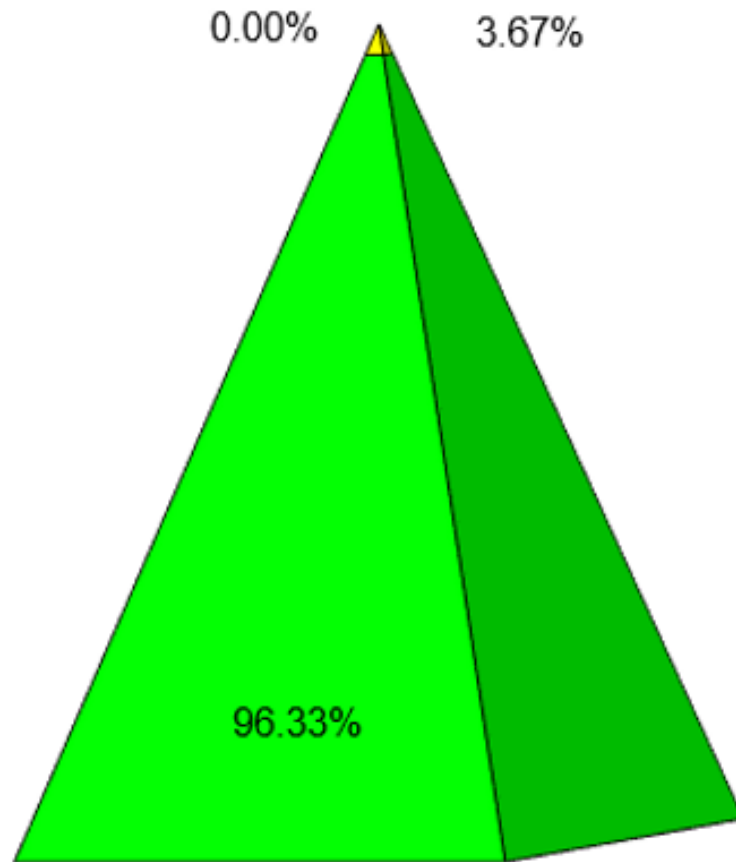

LEARNING INTENT: STUDENTS WILL UNDERSTAND THE PROCESS OF REPORTING VANDALISED/ BROKEN EQUIPMENT

Success Criteria:

- Students will be able to demonstrate how to respect school property and report any vandalised or broken equipment.

Vocabulary:

- Respect, vandalism

HOW DO YOU REPORT A VANDALISED OR BROKEN ITEM?

- In the classroom: Put your hand up and in a timely matter alert your teacher of the issue.
- In the playground: Alert the closest teacher on duty.
- The teacher will then follow-up in regard to reporting the issue to school groundsman to repair.
- If the damage could cause serious immediate injury, report to a teacher or the office if you cannot find one.



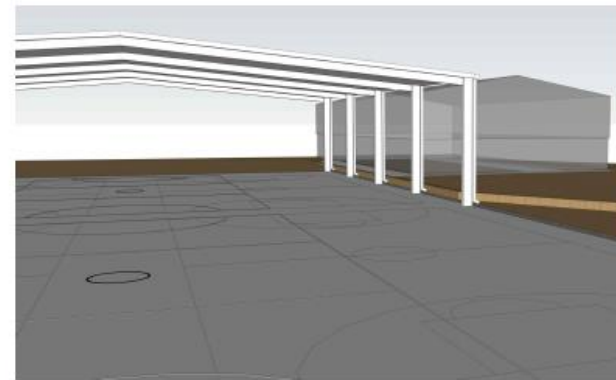
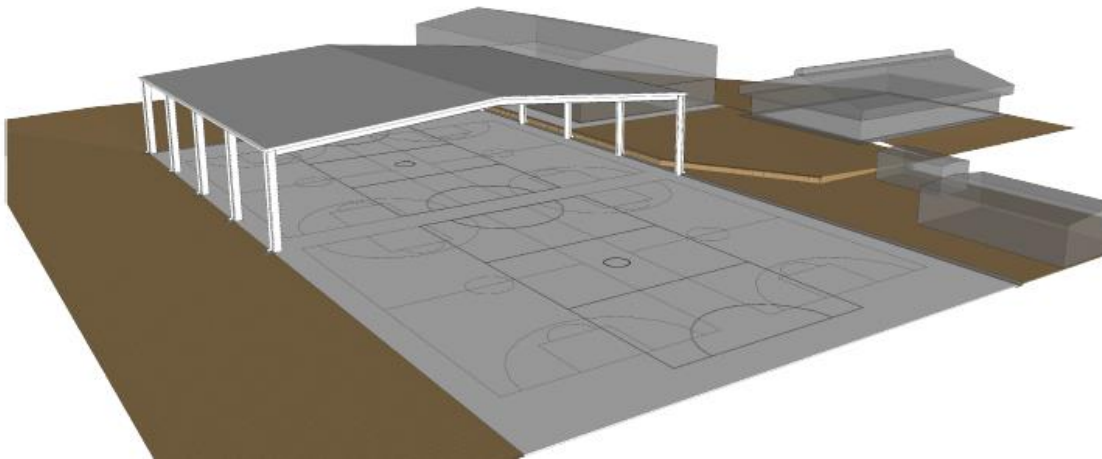
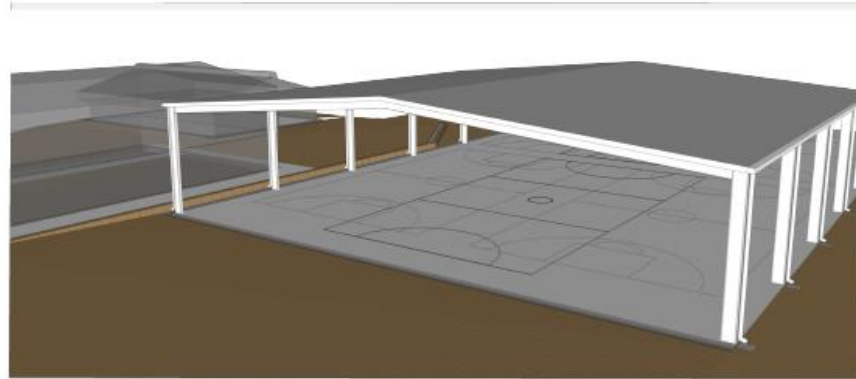
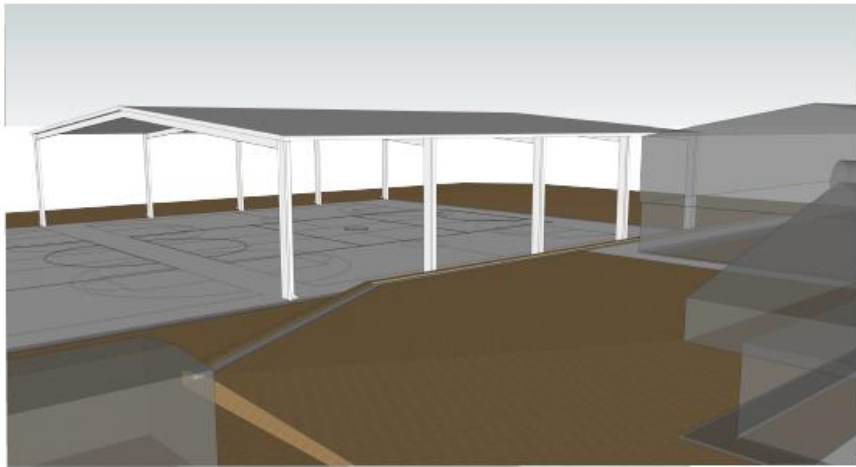
BUDGET COSTS

- Replace taps (\$285 per tap)
- Water bill(\$50 000 per year)
- Electricity bill(\$175 000 per year)
- Replace chairs this year(\$70 each chair) (\$2100 for 30)
- Replace desks this year (\$225 each) (\$6 750 for 30)
- Door locks (\$750 per lock)
- Rubbish removal (\$65 000)

PLANNED AND COMPLETED WORKS

- Library refurbishment (\$1 000 000)
- UCA refurbishment \$1 000 000
- Air-conditioner replacement (\$1 000 000) more due to cages needed to stop vandalism.

PLAYGROUND OR BUILDING

- If you suspect you have witnessed the damage or if the damage isn't as serious- go to the office and complete an incident form- this explains where the damage is (and whether you witnessed the damage occur)

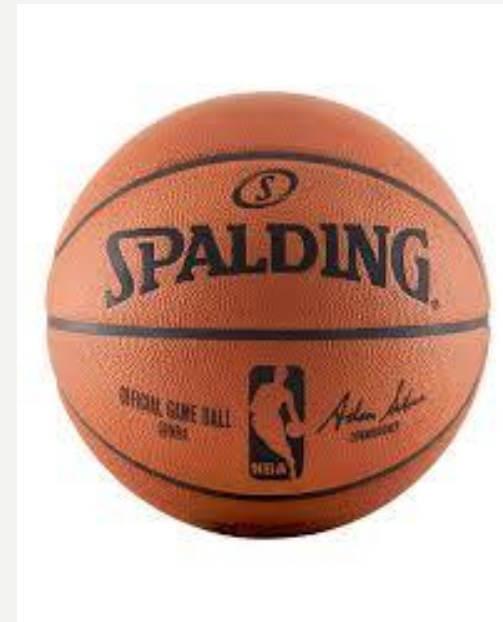


CLASSROOM EXAMPLE- ENGLISH

- You notice graffiti in a classroom textbook.
- Alert your teacher about the graffiti so that it can be removed.
- It is never ok to graffiti a desk or chair in a classroom.
Report any graffiti that you find. This includes graffiti that you find in a school resource such as a textbook.

HPE:

- Any damage you find to sports equipment, let your teacher know immediately. Do not place it back and not inform anyone.



HOME ECONOMICS

- Your teachers do a safety audit before you use certain equipment, however if you notice any damage, you are to inform your teacher straight away.



MANUAL ARTS:

- Your teachers do a safety audit before you use certain equipment, however if you notice any damage, you are to inform your teacher straight away.



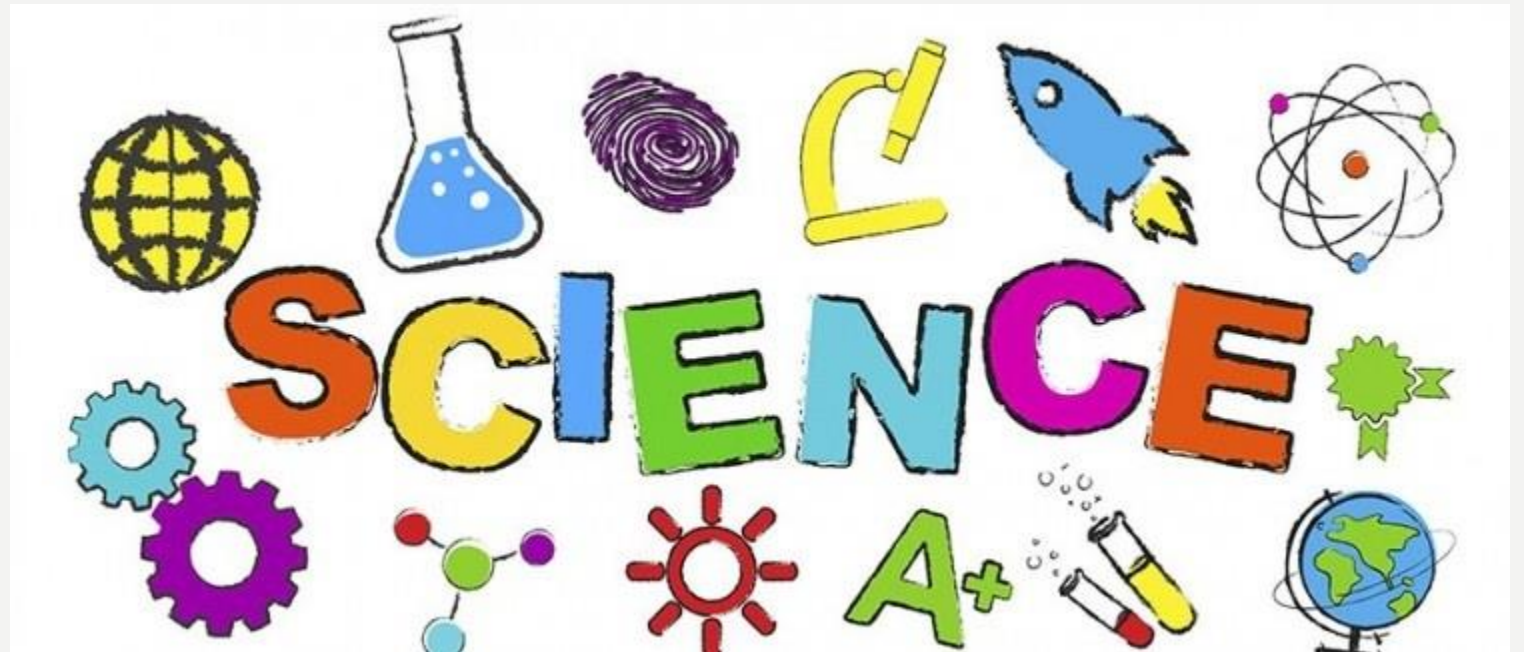
COMPUTER ROOMS:

- You need to actively check your computer for any faults and then report this to your teacher.



SCIENCE- PRACS

- Science pracs in the lab- report any damage that may have occurred during the prac, immediately. Eg- Damaged test tubes- class on ground.



REVIEW

- If you see someone vandalising school property report it immediately and complete an incident form at the office.
- If you see broken equipment in the classroom or in the playground report it to a teacher.
- Respect the property of the school. IT is provided to support and enhance your learning.
- Vandalism and disrespect of school property is unacceptable.
- Your teachers will recap this information during periods 2 – 4 today.
