

Activity consent form - Arts Camp 2020

Dear Parent/Carer

For Arts Camp 'curriculum outside the classroom' 2020 we will be travelling to Brisbane from the 30th of April and returning on the 4th of May. As there are strictly 50 spots available to students on this camp, only students who are currently enrolled in an Arts subject will be able to attend. In order for students to be able to attend, SRS fees must be paid or a payment plan commenced.

The aim of the camp is to provide an opportunity for our Arts students to experience their art form in real life as opposed to theoretically, which is often the case given our location.

Activity details:

We have attached an itinerary on the following page that outlines all of the activities that students will be able to participate in on this camp.

If your child will require any medication to be administered during the activity (including over the counter medication such as paracetamol), please contact the office so that the necessary paperwork can be completed.

Activity costs:

All costs associated with this camp have been outlined next to each activity on the attachment. The total cost for the Arts Camp 2020 is \$500. If you require a break down of the costs, please do not hesitate to contact Lucy Ferrara – Head of Department.

Please note that the following costs have not been included and students will need to bring their own money for:

- Thursday 30th April and Monday 4th May (travelling) money for morning tea, lunch and afternoon tea (recommended to bring snacks)
- Friday 1st May (Southbank) money for lunch
- Saturday 2nd May (Eat Street Markets) Entry fee (\$3) and money for dinner
- Sunday 3rd May (Movie World) money for lunch

Students are encouraged to participate in the Chocolate Drive fundraiser. The profit will be split evenly across all students attending the camp to assist in lowering the cost (this has been factored into the final cost of the camp already).

A deposit of \$100 will be required to be made at the front office by Friday 21st February to secure your place. Please note that there will be no reimbursement for deposits.

A final payment of \$400 will be required to be made at the front office by Friday 20th March.

REFUND POLICY: As the school cannot meet any shortfalls in funding for an excursion or camp due to the subsequent non-participation of a student who has previously indicated attendance of the activity, fees already paid for an excursion or camp may be refunded in full or in part or not at all, having regard to the associated expense incurred and the circumstances of the non-participation. All school fees must be up-to-date before students can participate in this activity.
