- Working as part of a team










Discuss: What do you think building respectful relationships feels like?

Relationships with Teachers/Teacher Aides



Teachers are responsible for guiding you and helping you to learn. You cannot treat them the same as a friend or a member of your family. You can develop good relationships with teachers/teacher aides and help them to do their job by:

- X Speaking and acting respectfully
- X Following instructions and listening to advice
- X Telling them if you are having problems
- X Thanking them if they help you
- X Politely encouraging others to do the right thing
- X Offering help if needed e.g. carrying books



Relationships with fellow students

As a student here you should strive to cooperate with all students at the school, not just friends or classmates. You can do this by:

Being a good role model in class

Working cooperatively in groups

Including everybody in activities

Being polite to fellow students

Accepting differences

Checking to see that someone is okay if you notice a problem

Participating in extra curricula activities which help you to meet more people
