School

Future Prep

To ensure you are:

SCENARIO

You are not feeling well and want to stay home from school today. You are worried about missing work in class.

What do you get your parents/caregiver to do?

What should you do to ensure you don't fall behind?

SCENARIO

What should Emily do to have her absences explained?

What could Emily do to assist her in getting help in understanding concepts that she missed while absent.

What could Emily do next time for this situation.

Emily has missed 2 days of school for the past five weeks. She did not contact her teachers regarding work missed. Her absences are still unexplained and she is now getting close to assessment time. She is feeling very confused with some of the concepts for her mathematics exam.

REVIEW

By being in class, every day, every lesson, you are ensuring that you are keeping up to date with assessment, are aware of the content in class and are getting the notices for curricular and extra-curricular activities.

By being in class, every day, every lesson, you are preparing yourself for the workforce where it is an expectation to turn up for work each day.
