By following staff instructions promptly you are actively practicing how to listen and take instructions from different people which is a skill that is very sought after.


CHOICE CHAT

Repeat the instruction – for example “I have asked you to move seats as you are interrupting the learning of the class”.

Allow take up time e.g. “I will give you a minute to follow that instruction” and will then walk away.


You then have a some time to reflect and make your choice
