EXAMPLES

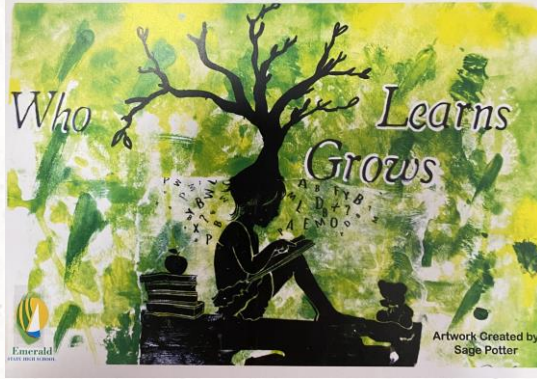
Positive examples

- ▶ Continually asking to borrow a pen.
