Seniors- being constantly late or out of class will be reflected on your School Reference. This could impact your future employment.


You disturb the learning of other students by interrupting, leaving the room, returning

Arriving 5 minutes late to one lesson a day equates to 50 minutes over the course of a term.  
Which is a total of more than 3 hours of school missed per year




**SO WHAT? WHY DOES IT MATTER?**



# SCENARIO 1- AIRPORT

- The check-in for your flight is at 09:00 and you arrive at 09:15 because you slept in

# SCENARIO 2- JOB INTERVIEW

- You have a job interview at 15:00 and you arrive at 15:07 because you did not get your clothes ready the night before and had to iron your shirt
- What do you think the response will be from your prospective employer?



# SCENARIO 3- WORKPLACE

- Your Saturday morning shift starts at 7:00, but the last 3 Saturday's you have slept in because you have been up until 2am.
- Your boss has had to cover for you each Saturday while waiting for you to arrive
- What do you think the outcome of this continued behaviour will be?
